
VALÈNCIA


- ➤ Third largest city in Spain (1,5 million people), with a Mediterranean lifestyle, mild climate and 322 days of sunshine per year.

 - ▶ Farmland tours...









VENUE

- Universitat Politècnica de València (UPV), (www.upv.es/index-en.html): Spain's top technological university according to the major global rankings assessing higher education quality.
- ➤ Over 42,000 members: about 37,800 students, 2,600 lecturers and 1,700 management and service personnel.
- ➤ 15 schools and faculties
- ➤ UPV's Vera Campus:
 - ➤ 25 minutes walk from the historic center and 15 minutes from the Malvarrosa Beach.
 - ➤ Simple access by urban bus, metro + tram or bicycle.
 - ➤ Designed to move on foot, with a size of 700,000 m², and 100,000 m² of green areas.
 - Suited to host conferences and workshops.

- By plane: Valencia International Airport
 - ➤ Direct flights to main European cities: Amsterdam, Barcelona, Brussels, Dublin, Dusseldorf, Eindhoven, Frankfurt, Geneva, Glasgow, Hamburg, Lisbon, London, Madrid, Milan, Moscow, Munich, Paris, Prague, Rome, Stuttgart, Zurich,....
 - ➤ Easy transit connections from/to America and Asia through main European hubs: Madrid, London, Francfurt, Zurich,...
 - ➤ Distance to City: Centre 8 km. Metro station connects directly with the city centre
