

Edward Maginn Receives New Dorini Family Chair of Energy Studies

In addition to serving as the chair of the Department of Chemical and Biomolecular Engineering, Maginn is recognized for his teaching and research accomplishments. His research focuses on computational statistical thermodynamics, in which atomistic-level computational methods are developed and utilized to obtain a fundamental understanding of the link between the physical properties of materials and their chemical constitution, with a particular focus on the development of new materials related to energy applications. He has been the principal investigator or co-principal investigator for more than 45 externally funded grants totaling approximately \$20 million. He holds two patents and is the author of more than 100 peer-reviewed articles and several book chapters. He has also graduated 16 Ph.D. students and mentored 12 postdoctoral associates during his tenure at Notre Dame. This is in addition to the numerous awards he has won for teaching.
