

University-Industry Workshop on Integration of Simulation Technology at Cornell University

Cornell University will be hosting a university-industry workshop on the integration of simulation technology into the engineering curriculum.

The workshop will be held July 25-26, 2008 on the Cornell University campus in Ithaca, NY. This workshop will be of interest to all engineering faculty who use or would like to use simulation technology in their courses and projects. It will also be of interest to engineers in industry who work with simulation technology. Technology areas to be considered include computer-aided design, finite-element analysis, computational fluid dynamics and heat transfer, multi-body dynamics and control, and numerical analysis. There will be participation from major engineering software vendors. A wiki-based website will be unveiled at the workshop to facilitate the creation of online learning modules, sharing of curriculum materials and collaboration.
